Students develop the client-centered communication skills and professional practices needed to recommend lifestyle adjustments, which effect long term changes in their clients' health and wellbeing.

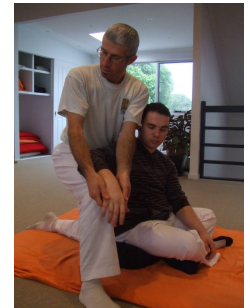
